Game Summary - First Impressions

Call of Duty Mobile is the mobile version of Call of Duty's multiplayer arena-style game. In this game, you will be paired up into a team and paired against another team. The game goes until one of the teams has completed all of the objectives.

Players are paired with other players of similar rank and ability, and the map and objectives are randomly selected. You will have a starting weapon with limited ammo, but other weapons can be picked up from fallen players. The goal is usually to defeat as many players from the opposite team as possible, but as you progress you get better gear, and more interesting challenges.

After level seven form the standard multiplayer version, the battle royale mode will be unlocked. The Battle Royale mode will see you versus a hundred other players. You will be airdropped onto a map, and then need to duke it out. The last person standing is the winner. The matchmaking is well done and leveled so you will always be grouped with players of similar ability. Also, you will not need to worry about overpowered players being put into the mix.

Gameplay

The gameplay for Call of Duty Mobile is a bit awkward at first. The screen is crowded with about 20 buttons, and it can make play a bit awkward. Especially when so much of the screen is covered by buttons. The controls are not as well done as similar types of games. Other games in this space have figured out their controls a lot better.

Though you do get to keep and upgrade your gear which is a major plus, the maps could use more ammo drops. It is easy to run out of ammo quickly especially in the beginning before you upgrade your gear. This can slow down the gameplay at first. ### Final Thoughts

The Call of Duty mobile game is a good game, but in this space, other games have much better gameplay and controls. It fails to be a great strategy game and quickly becomes a runaround and shoot them kind of game. This is great if you like those types of games, but if you are looking for a more realistic type of battle simulator you will need to look elsewhere.

All in all, it is a good stripped down version of the Call of Duty franchise. If you enjoy the Call of Duty games, then you will like this game.
